- Williams Heights Elementary School is **Beating the Odds**, meaning that it performs better than similar schools.

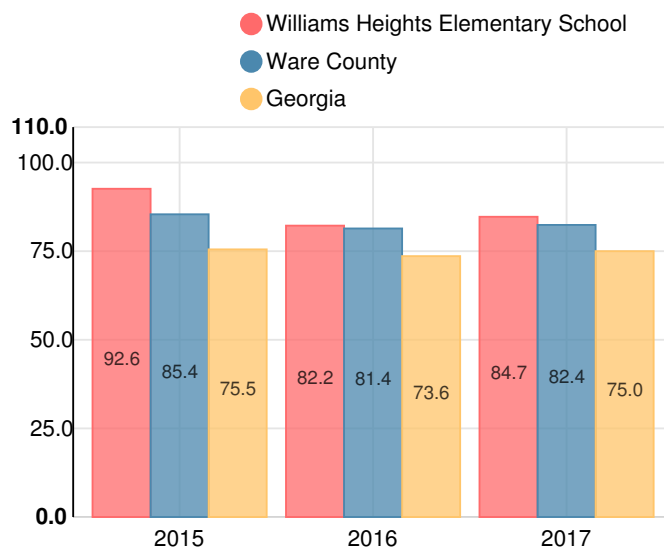

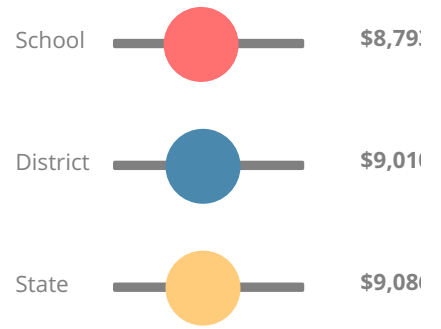
School Climate Star Rating



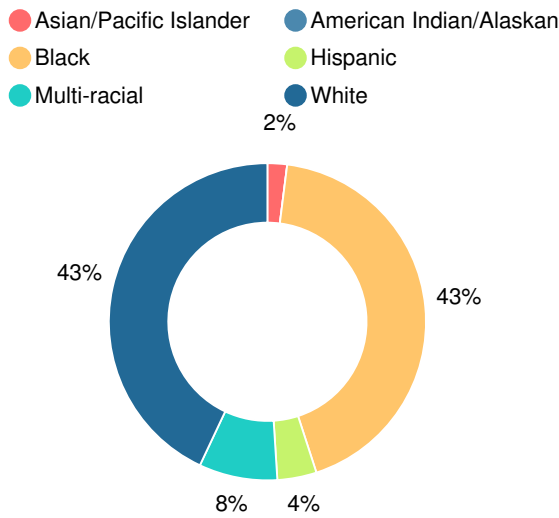
Financial Efficiency Star Rating



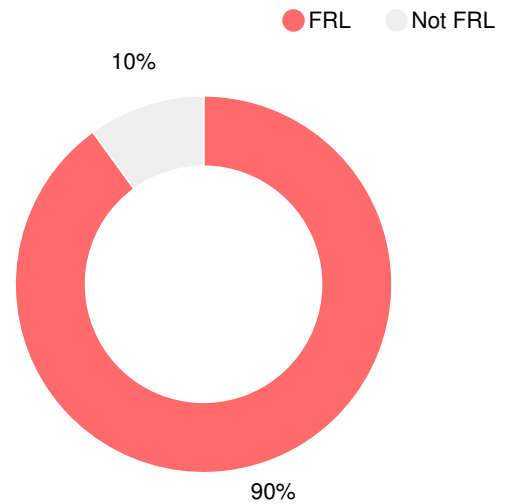
Per Pupil Expenditures



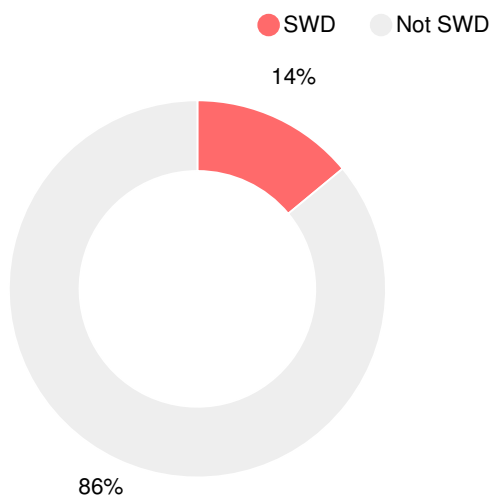

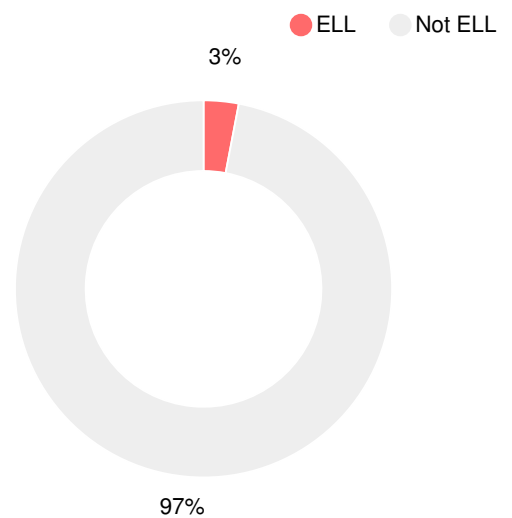

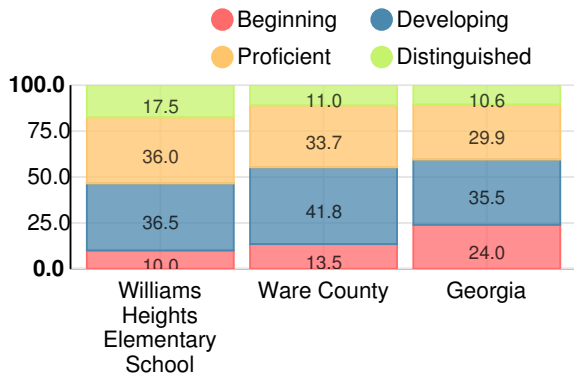

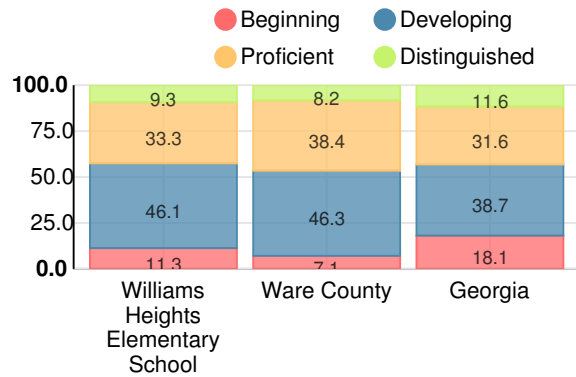

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



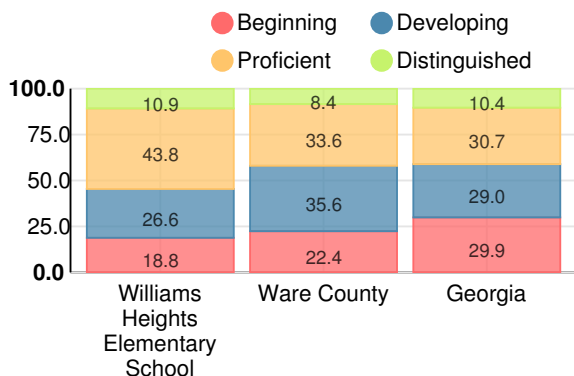
### Mathematics

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



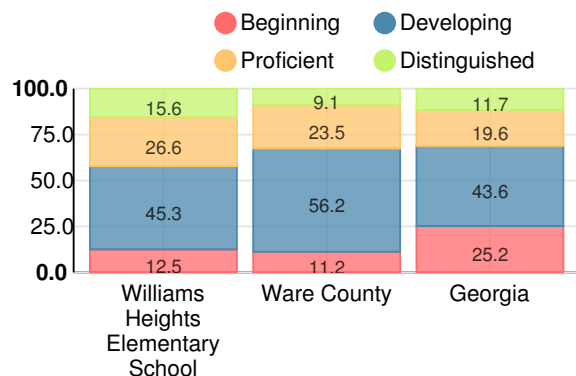
### Science

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



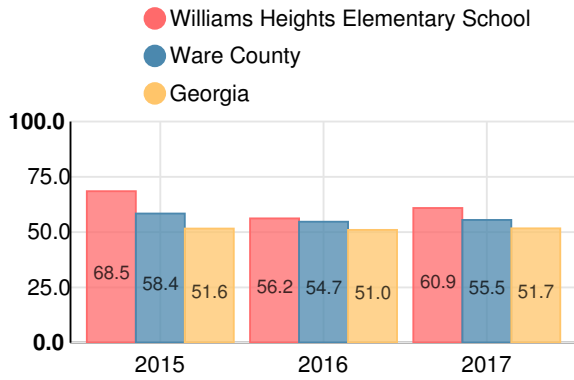
